We would recommend 18 gauge (1.2mm), 16 gauge (1.5mm), or thicker.

How do I choose a good stainless steel sink for my kitchen?

- It should be about 1-2mm in thickness



- Go for a thicker gauge for better durability
- Consider the sink size you need for your space
- Check if you need it to be made in grade 304 or 316 stainless steel
